Invitation to Bid

1) The TESDA ISAT, through the Sariling Sikap Program-Fund Savings 2025 intends to apply the sum of

Two Million One Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty and 94/100 Pesos (Php. 2,185,550.94) – Lot 1 Renovation of Early Childhood Care and Development NC III Workshop and Storage Facilities/IP2025-001

Three Million Four Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Eighty-Eight and 65/100 Pesos (Php. 3,492,088.65) – Lot 2 Second (2nd) Phase of the Proposed Construction of Incubation Facility/IP2025-002

Two Million One Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-One and 96/100 Pesos (Php. 2,151,441.96) – Lot 3 Proposed Extension of SMAW/Construction Workshop/IP2025-003

being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for each lot. Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- The TESDA ISAT now invites bids for the three lot infrastructure project (see attached bill of quantities).³ Completion of the Works is required for **120 days**. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders (ITB).
- 3) Bidding will be conducted through competitive bidding procedures using a nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR, otherwise known as the "New Government Procurement Act (NGPA)".
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
- 4) Interested bidders may obtain further information from TESDA ISAT and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday.

³ A brief description of the scope of Works should be provided, including quantities, location of project, and other information necessary to enable potential bidders to decide whether or not to respond to the invitation.

- A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **November 04, 2025** from the address below and upon payment of applicable/non-refundable fee for the bidding documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by GPPB, in the amount of **Php. 5,000 per lot.**
 - It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
- The TESDA ISAT will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on November 12, 2025; 10:00 AM at TESDA ISAT Calamagui 2nd, City of Ilagan, Isabela for Pre-Bid Conference, and/or through video conferencing via zoom/google meet, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- Bids must be duly received by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before 10:00 AM of November 24, 2025. Bidder's representative shall present Valid Company ID and Special Power of Attorney (SPA) to the BAC Secretariat in order to be allowed to submit their bids. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8) All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 16.
- Bid opening shall be on November 24, 2025; 10:00 AM at TESDA ISAT Calamagui 2nd, City of Ilagan, Isabela and/or zoom/google meet. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
- 10) Bidder's may submit their bids through courier services at the bidder's own risk on the date and time at the address stated above. Bid submitted after the deadline shall not be accepted. Submission of bids through e-mail are not yet allowed.
- 11) The TESDA ISAT reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 70 of R.A. No. 12009, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
